TV Measurement Guide

To accurately determine whether or not your TV, or the TV you intend to buy, will fit a certain cabinet style, you must measure the TV's three dimensions: width, height, and depth.

Step 1: Measure the width

Using a tape measure, **measure the width** of your TV by extending a tape measure horizontally across the entire TV unit. Be certain to include the entire TV frame in your measurement. Enter this width into the chart below.



Step 2: Measure the height

Measure the height of your TV by extending a tape measure vertically across the TV unit. Be certain to include the entire TV frame in your measurement. Enter this height into the chart below.



Step 3: Measure the depth

Measure the depth of your TV by extending a tape measure across the thickest part of your TV unit. Do not include in your depth measurement any TV stand that may be included with your unit. Enter this depth into the chart below.
